School Annual Education Report (AER) Cover Letter Tri County High School

February 15, 2024

Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2022-2023 educational progress for Tri County High School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. If you have any questions about the AER, please contact Principal Tim Goheen for assistance.

The AER is available for you to review electronically by visiting the following website www.tricountyschools.com, or you may review a copy in the main office at your child's school.

For the 2022-23 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2022-23. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school **has not** been given one of these labels.

There are a number of key challenges that face students and staff at Tri County High School. SAT data has been released and our school improvement team analyzed the data and found the following results. Based on Spring 2023 SAT scores, the percent of students who were proficient in English Language Arts was 52%, in Math 20%. These compared to the state averages of 52% in English Language Arts, 30% in Math. Our teaching staff at Tri County High School continues to work extremely hard to develop an aligned curriculum in English Language Arts, Science and Mathematics. We continue to build our curriculum using state standards within all departments.

State law requires that we also report additional information.

1. PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO THE SCHOOL

Pupils are assigned to Tri County High School based on grade level and how many credits received each semester. Classes are also scheduled based on future educational goals and test scores.

2. **THE STATUS OF THE 3-5 YEAR SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN**

Tri County High School staff has developed a 3-5 year school improvement plan. Our goals have been designed based on analysis of student achievement data.

3. **A BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF EACH SPECIALIZED SCHOOL**

While the district does not offer a specialized school, we continue to maintain a plethora of elective classes.

4. **IDENTIFY HOW TO ACCESS A COPY OF THE CORE CURRICULUM, A DESCRIPTION OF ITS IMPLEMENTATION, AND AN EXPLANATION OF THE VARIANCES FROM THE STATE'S MODEL**

A copy of our High School curriculum is available for review in our High School office. Our curriculum has been created to align with both the state and federal government standards. We use the Gradual Release of Responsibility framework for teaching and use Adaptive Schools instructional strategies.

5. **THE AGGREGATE STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT RESULTS FOR ANY LOCAL COMPETENCY TESTS OR NATIONALLY NORMED ACHIEVEMENT TESTS**

Students at Tri County High School in grades 9-11 take the PSAT/SAT to measure achievement and growth in areas of English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies. Below are the results for our students who take the SAT during their Junior year.

SAT 2022 Results

Tri County students scored an average of 946 compared to the state average of 959. Tri County had 25% of students meet both ERW and Math benchmarks with the following breakdown: 46% meeting ERW, and 26% meeting Math benchmarks. The State recorded 28% meeting both benchmarks with the following breakdown: 52% meeting ERW, and 30% meeting Math.

SAT 2023 Results

Tri County students scored an average of 939 compared to the state average of 958. Tri County had 20% of students meet both ERW and Math benchmarks with the following breakdown: 52% meeting ERW, and 20% meeting Math benchmarks. The State recorded 28% meeting both benchmarks with the following breakdown: 52% meeting ERW, and 30% meeting Math.

6. **IDENTIFY THE NUMBER AND PERCENT OF STUDENTS REPRESENTED BY PARENTS AT PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES**

In 2021-2022 during our Fall parent-teacher conferences, we had 26% attendance.

During our Spring parent-teacher conferences, we had 27% attendance.

In 2022-2023 during our Fall parent-teacher conferences, we had 27% attendance.

During our Spring parent-teacher conferences, we had 21% attendance.

a. **THE NUMBER AND PERCENT OF POSTSECONDARY ENROLLMENTS (DUAL ENROLLMENT)**

During the 2021-2022 school year, Tri County High School had 80 students enrolled in college classes which equates to 14% of our student body.

During the 2022-2023 school year, Tri County High School had 75 students enrolled in college classes which equates to 14% of our student body.

b. THE NUMBER OF COLLEGE EQUIVALENT COURSES OFFERED (AP/IB)

During the 2021-2022 school year, Tri County High School offered AP English and AP Computer Science.

During the 2022-2023 school year, Tri County High School offered AP English.

c. THE NUMBER AND PERCENTAGE OF STUDENTS ENROLLED IN COLLEGE EQUIVALENT COURSES (AP/IB)

During the 2021-2022 school year, Tri County High School had 35 students enrolled in an AP class. This equates to 6% of our student body.

During the 2022-2023 school year, Tri County High School had 13 students enrolled in an AP class. This equates to 3% of our student body.

d. THE NUMBER AND PERCENTAGE OF STUDENTS RECEIVING A SCORE LEADING TO COLLEGE CREDIT

During the 2021-2022 School Year, Tri County High School had 13 students receive a score for college credit. This equates to 54% of our students who took the AP exam.

During the 2022-2023 School Year, Tri County High School had 13 students receive a score for college credit. This equates to 46% of our students who took the AP exam.

Our unique location provides our students with countless opportunities that most other high school students do not have access to. Tri County students have access to two career centers and have earned college credit at 5 different colleges. Typically, we have up to 7 college classes a year hosted at our High School campus. Our staff is committed to providing quality academic opportunities and other supportive services to ensure all students achieve their best future.
